Post-production tends to be priced separately unless a studio explicitly bundles it. Raw, unedited files are the cheapest deliverable, but if you want a polished episode with levels balanced and filler removed, that work carries its own cost regardless of who does it.

Studios generally prefer longer bookings because it fills their schedule more efficiently than a string of short one-hour sessions.

Request an itemized quote rather than a single lump figure. Seeing room time, editing, and any add-ons broken out separately makes it far easier to spot where your money is actually going, and it gives you leverage to trim what you don't need.

- Are revisions to the edit included, or charged separately?
- Does the quote include both audio and video, or just one?
